STANDING RULES

1. **Name:** The official name of the presbytery shall be Arkansas Presbytery of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church, Inc.
2. **Fiscal Year:** The Fiscal Year for Arkansas Presbytery shall be the calendar year.
3. **Meetings:** The presbytery shall meet once a year in two sessions, on the second Friday and Saturday in March and on the second Friday and Saturday in September. Starting time for the Friday sessions is 7:00 p.m.

The March session shall consist of any essential business and shall include a worship service and Holy Communion on the first day. The second day shall include a reading of the Memorial Roll for the previous calendar year and a worship time from 11:30 A.M. until 12:00 Noon.

The September session shall be devoted to any business at hand and shall include a worship service led by the CPYF of A on the first day. The second day shall include a worship time from 11:30

4. **Program Committee:** The moderator, stated clerk, and pastor host shall be the program committee.

A member of the Board of Christian Education shall assist in the planning of the Presbyterial Programs. A.M. until 12:00 Noon.

5. **Meeting Places:** Selection of Meeting places shall be made from invitations from churches.
6. **Membership:** The membership of the presbytery consists of the ministers and an elder delegate from each of the particular churches on its roll. Members in good standing in other presbyteries may be seated as Advisory Members, and have the privilege of the floor but not of voting. Ministers in good standing of other ecclesiastical bodies may be officially recognized as Visiting.
7. **Quorum:** Four members shall constitute a quorum of presbytery provided that at least one minister and at least one elder are present.
8. **Attendance, Ministers:** All ministers who are members, all probationers who are under the care of the presbytery, and all stated supplies who are serving churches in the presbytery shall attend each regular session of the presbytery or advise the presbytery in writing of the reason for non-attendance and request to be excused.

Exceptions are to be made with respect to ministers who are permanently excused (E-P), or missionaries serving outside the continental United States (E-M), or chaplains who are on active duty (E-C). These shall be excused without the necessity of a written excuse. The Committee on the Ministry shall be responsible for recommending to the presbytery the persons for whom Exceptions are to be made. The initiative for any requests for ministers who are retired and/or disabled to be permanently excused shall rest with the minister; through communication with the

Committee on the Ministry. (See Handbook Appendix B for Permanent Excuse Form)

9. **Attendance, Elders:** All congregations in the presbytery shall be represented at each session of presbytery by duly elected elder delegates or advise the presbytery in writing why the congregation will not be represented and request that the congregation be excused. Elder delegates shall be certified at least 20 days prior to the meeting of presbytery on a form provided by the stated clerk. Elders must be current members of the church session in order to be eligible to serve as delegates. An elder not elected by the session may be seated by presbytery. There may be exceptional instances that would make it proper for the presbytery to accept evidence other than election by the church session as the right of a ruling elder to represent his/her church session. (C. P. Digest 5.4)

10. **Excuses:** All excuses for non-attendance shall be examined by members present of the Committee on Judicial Concerns 30 minutes prior to starting time of each session of presbytery, and then presented to the presbytery.

Only presbytery may act on reasons for non-attendance, or approve ones leaving prior to final adjournment. The General Assembly has ruled that presbytery excuses Ministers and Church Sessions, not Elder Delegates. It is the responsibility of the church session to consider requests to be excused by specific Elder Delegates.

11. **Roll Call:** Roll call at the Friday evening session and the Saturday Morning session shall be by ministers and elder delegates turning in a form provided by the stated clerk. The final roll will be called by the stated clerk and will be the last order of business on Saturday.

12. **Special/Called Meetings:** The moderator shall call a special meeting at the request of two ministers, and two elders from different churches. The call shall give notice, specifying the Particular business of the intended meeting, to every minister and session of every church on its roll, at least ten days prior to the proposed time of the meeting. Nothing shall be transacted at such special meeting other than the particular business for which the presbytery was convened. (See Handbook Appendix A for the proper form for initiating a call for a special/called meeting)

13. **Officers:** The officers of the presbytery shall be the moderator, vice-moderator, stated clerk/treasurer, assistant stated clerk/treasurer, and trustees.

a. **The Moderator** shall be elected in the March session to serve for a period of one year. The duties of the moderator are set forth in the Presbytery Handbook at 4.1

b. **The Vice Moderator** shall be elected in the March session to serve for a period of one year. The duties of the vice moderator are set forth in the Presbytery Handbook, at 4.2.

Arkansas Presbytery has established a tradition of electing the vice moderator to succeed the moderator.

c. **The Stated Clerk/Treasurer** shall be elected at the September session for a three-year term beginning January 1. (Exceptions may be made in case of a vacancy in the office). An appropriate honorarium shall be paid and shall be reviewed annually in the preparation of the budget. The

budget shall also include amounts for travel expense and office expense. The duties of the stated clerk/treasurer is set forth in the Presbytery Handbook at 4.3 and 4.6. The stated clerk treasurer may or may not be a member of presbytery.

d. **The Assistant Stated Clerk/Treasurer** shall be elected at the September session for a three-year term beginning January 1. (Exceptions may be made in case of a vacancy in the office.) The duties of the assistant stated clerk/treasurer are set forth in the Presbytery Handbook at 4.4. The assistant stated clerk/treasurer may or may not be a member of the presbytery and shall serve without compensation.

e. **A Recording Clerk** may be appointed by the stated clerk at any session to record the minutes of the session and perform other tasks assigned by the stated clerk. The recording clerk may or may not be a member of the presbytery and shall serve without compensation. See Presbytery Handbook, at 4.5.

f. **The Trustees** of the presbytery shall be the members of the Board of Finance, the Moderator, and the Stated Clerk, and shall act in that capacity when so directed by the presbytery. The officers of the Trustees shall be the same as the officers of the Board of Finance. Deeds, Oil and Gas Leases, and other legal documents shall be signed by at least three trustees; usually the Moderator, the Stated Clerk, and the Chairperson of the Board of Finance and Trustees.

14. **The Executive Committee** shall consist of the moderator, vice moderator, stated clerk/treasurer, assistant stated clerk/treasurer, and the chairpersons of the presbyterial boards and standing committees. The duties of the executive committee are set forth in the Presbytery Handbook at 7.1. Pages 44 and 45
15. **Preliminary Minutes:** All program reports and financial reports of presbytery boards, committees, and task forces shall be sent to the stated clerk within 5 days of the February and August board meetings. The stated clerk shall assemble and staple these reports into preliminary minutes, which shall be mailed to each minister, elder delegate, and the chairperson of each board, committee and task force, at least 15 days prior to each session of the presbytery. See Presbytery Handbook, 4.304.
16. **Minutes:** It shall be the duty of the stated clerk to record all minutes in permanent form. Each item of business shall be in a separate paragraph and headings given to as many items as is practical. When a report by a board or other agency of presbytery is edited by the board or committee during presentation, or amended by presbytery, the stated clerk shall retype the report, renumbering recommendations if necessary, so that the report as printed in the minutes will be what was approved by presbytery. The minutes of the March session of presbytery shall be printed and distributed by June and the minutes of the September session by December. The stated clerk shall sign the original minutes of each session. See Presbytery Handbook, 4.305, page 12. 17.
17. **Eligibility to Serve on Presbytery Boards and Standing Committees:** Any minister who is a member of Arkansas Presbytery and anyone who is a member of a Cumberland Presbyterian Church in Arkansas Presbytery shall be eligible to serve on any presbytery board or committee, with one exception. The exception is, no minister who serves a church, which receives benefits

from the presbytery, and no member of a church, which receives benefits from the presbytery, should be a member of the board, which oversees, or makes recommendations, with regard to those benefits. See Presbytery Handbook, 6.811 Page 41, and C. P. Digest 5.60

18. **All Presbyterial Boards and Standing Committees:** All information regarding number of members, terms of office, duties, responsibilities, etc., of each board and Committee is included under the Section for that particular board or committee. (See the Handbook, Contents, 6.0, page 3 for page numbers and applicable appendices.)
19. **Commissions:** The presbytery may elect commissions, which are authorized to deliberate upon and conclude the business submitted to them, subject to the review of presbytery. Stipulations concerning commissions are set forth in the Presbytery Handbook at 7.3 Pages 45 and 46.
20. **Other Committees:** The presbytery shall raise such other committees, as it deems appropriate. See Presbytery Handbook, 7.2 Page 45.
21. **Minister Commissioners to General Assembly:** Two Primary Minister Commissioners to General Assembly and two Alternates shall be elected at the fall session of presbytery. The Nominations Committee shall select ministers to be nominated in alphabetical order. See Presbytery Handbook 4.901 Page 18.
22. **Elder Commissioners to General Assembly:** Two primary elder Commissioners to General Assembly and two alternates shall be elected at the fall session of presbytery. The Nominations Committee shall select elders to be nominated based upon an alphabetical listing of the churches. See Presbytery Handbook, 4.902 Page 18.
23. **Youth Advisory Delegates to General Assembly:** Two Primary Youth Advisory Delegates and two alternates shall be elected by the fall session of presbytery. The Nominations Committee shall select youths to be nominated from names submitted by the churches of the presbytery. See Presbytery Handbook, 4.903 Page 18.
24. **Minister Delegates to The Synod of Great Rivers:** Three Primary Minister Delegates and three alternates shall be elected at the fall session of the presbytery, prior to each even numbered year. The Nominations Committee shall use the same system used for selection of minister commissioners to the General Assembly. See Presbytery Handbook 4.906 Page 18.
25. **Elder Delegates to The Synod of Great Rivers:** Three Primary Elder Delegates and three alternates shall be elected at the fall session of presbytery, prior to each even numbered year. The Nominations Committee shall use the same system used for elder delegates to the General Assembly. See Presbytery Handbook 4.907 Page 19.
26. **Travel Expense:** Travel expense for board and committee members and others, on official presbyterial business, shall be reimbursed at the rate of 35 cents per mile (unless the board member elects not to receive reimbursement), plus other actual expenses. It is the responsibility of the

board or committee chair to turn in a list of travel expenses to the stated clerk/treasurer. Travel expense for delegates to the Synod of Great Rivers shall be included in the presbyterial budget.

For travel expense of Commissioners to the General Assembly see the Presbytery Handbook at Board of Finance 6.406a, Page 32.

27. **The Stated Clerk shall update the Standing Rules and the Arkansas Presbytery Handbook of Operation** following each session of presbytery.
28. **The Stated Clerk shall keep a list, including the name and address of each person who receives a copy of the Handbook** in order that they may be mailed pages, which have been changed, following each update. (See Handbook under Stated Clerk at 4.310.)
29. **The following persons shall be provided a copy of the Handbook:**
Each minister who is a member of the presbytery; each licentiate; each candidate for the ministry; each church session clerk; and the chairperson, secretary, and treasurer of each presbyterial board and standing committee. Others who want a copy of the Handbook should send a written request to the stated clerk.
30. **Amendments to The Standing Rules and the Arkansas Presbytery Handbook of Operation:**
The Standing Rules and the Arkansas Presbytery Handbook of Operation may be amended by a two-thirds vote of members present and voting at any meeting of the presbytery.

THE COMMISSION APPOINTED BY MODERATOR KEITH CLEMENT WERE ELDER JERRY MEINZER (CHAIRMAN), REV. ALAN MEINZER, REV. ROBERTA JOHNSON, REV NICHOLAS CHAMBERS, AND REV. MICHAEL SUTTLE.

ON NOVEMBER 28, 1955, JACK JOHNSON AND HIS WIFE OSA JOHNSON DEEDED LAND TO K.T. ALLEN (DEED READS K.T.) MEMORIAL CUMBERLAND PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH, FOR THE SUM OF \$1.00 AND OTHER GOOD AND VALUABLE CONSIDERATIONS. FOLLOWING THE LEGAL DESCRIPTION, THE FOLLOWING WAS PRINTED: "IF AT ANY TIME THIS PROPERTY IS NOT USED FOR CHURCH PURPOSES IT REVERTS BACK TO THE GRANTORS OR THEIR HEIRS". COURTS HAVE RULED THAT REVERSION CLAUSES OF THIS TYPE ARE ENFORCEABLE.

ON NOVEMBER 8, 2019, ALL MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION MET AT THE CAMDEN CP FELLOWSHIP CHURCH TO DISCUSS THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE E.T. ALLEN CP CHURCH. PRIOR COMMUNICATION HAD REVEALED THAT CHURCH WAS NOW CALLED "CHRISTION FELLOWSHIP – E.T. ALLEN MEMORIAL"

ON NOVEMBER 9, 2019, THE FOLLOWING COMMISSION MEMBERS MET WITH THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP CHURCH: ELDER JERRY MEINZER, REV. ALAN MEINZER, REV. MICHAEL SUTTLE, AND ARKANSAS PRESBYTERY MODERATOR KEITH CLEMENT. THOSE REPRESENTING CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP WERE REV. RAY CROMER, CLERK GLEN BOWMAN, AND ATTORNEY ERIC T. BISHOP, ALONG WITH SEVERAL CHURCH MEMBERS.

WHEN ASKED FOR THEIR THOUGHTS ON HOW TO HANDLE THE REVERSION CLAUSE ON THE DEED IF 15 OR MORE PEOPLE DID NOT RESPOND TO THE NEWSPAPER AD IN THE ASHDOWN LITTLE RIVER NEWS. THEIR ANSWER WAS THAT THEY WOULD LOCATE THE HEIRS AND HAVE ALL NECESSARY PAPER WORK COMPLETED BY DECEMBER 31, 2019. AT THIS POINT BOTH PARTIES WOULD AWAIT ARKANSAS PRESBYTERY VOTE ON RELINQUISHING ALL CLAIM TO SAID PROPERTY.

CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP ALSO AGREED TO TURN OVER ALL AVAILABLE CHURCH RECORDS, PROOF OF INSURANCE ON THE CHURCH, AND A COPY OF THEIR BANK STATEMENT FOR DECEMBER 2016. THIS HAS ALL BEEN HANDLED.



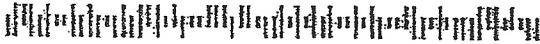

The History and Heritage Committee of Arkansas Presbytery submits the following report for consideration and action.

Officers of the committee are Bobby Coleman, Chair and Kitty Stamps, Secretary. Bobby Coleman will be representing the committee at this meeting of presbytery.

I

Historical Markers

Arkansas Presbytery instructed this committee to place historical markers at the two oldest Cumberland Presbyterian Churches in Arkansas; namely, Mt. Olive and Milligan Campground Churches.

The committee seeks additional directive in order to fulfill this requirement. The committee needs guideline concerning the amount of money available for this project. Available funds have direct impact on type of material used and text to be inscribed. The committee will have cost estimates for different materials at presbytery.

II

Events of Historical Significance

An ordination service of a minister is of significance to presbytery and the church at large. Technology now provides the opportunity to document this event beyond printed medium, therefore;

Recommendation 1; the committee recommends that Arkansas Presbytery authorize the purchase of a video camera for the purposes of: a) recording all ordinations of ministers, and b) other events of historical significance.

The Committee on Ministry is aware and fully supportive of this project.

III

Cane Hill College

This committee has made a request to the Cane Hill Preservation Society for a presentation about Cane Hill College. This presentation would be made at a meeting of Arkansas Presbytery, therefore;

Recommendation 2: that Arkansas Presbytery with the Fort Smith Cumberland Presbyterian Church at the March 12-13, 2021 meeting.

The Grace Cumberland Presbyterian Church, Fayetteville, will be co-hosting this event.

Board of Christian Education Committee
Arkansas Presbytery

The Christian Education Committee of the Arkansas Presbytery met on February 1, 2020 at Sherwood CP Church. Chairman Terry Shatley called the meeting to order and declared a quorum present with the following members: Josh Mays, Kathy DeWoody, and Nadine Rail.

Opening prayer by Chairman Shatley. Josh Mays was named Chairman with Nadine Rail as Secretary.

Absence of Rev. Joel Snyder, who received a permanent excuse, was discussed. He is not able to serve remainder of his term, ending September 2020. When mentioned to Stated Clerk, Janie Stamps, Rev. Buster Guthrie was appointed to serve the remainder of Rev. Snyder's term.

Board Report

February 1, 2020

With a quorum present, The Arkansas Board of Missions was called to order at approximately 9:35 a.m. at the Sherwood CP Church with the opening prayer lead by Rev. Chris Anderson. Members present: Rev. Nicholas Chambers, Mrs. Liz Skidmore, Mr. Billy Clinton, Rev. Chris Anderson, Mrs. Melinda Reams, Mrs. Rockie Pederson, Mrs. Susan Suttle, Rev. Alan Meinzer, Mr. Mike Van Meter, and secretary Mr. Mickey Shell.

At the request of the Stated Clerk the first order of business was the election of board officers. The board elected Melinda Reams as Chair, Rev. Nick Chambers as Vice Chair, Mickey Shell as Secretary, and Joyce Shell as Treasurer.

Treasurer's Report: The board reviewed the report of the treasurer and on motion, the board approved this report.

Old Business:

BOM Workshop at Spring Meeting of Arkansas Presbytery

The workshop for the Spring meeting of Arkansas Presbytery was discussed and planned. The denominational MMT has staff developing a program for discernment and development of goals for small congregations. Once this program is completed, the board will plan a workshop for a future meeting of Presbytery. The concept of a parish sharing of a minister with two churches, and the possibility of a Presbyterian Pastor will be discussed as future BOM projects. This workshop will be "Looking at Ministry from a Different View." Rev. Lisa Anderson will do a 30 minute presentation, others will tell of outreach into the community or videos of activities to reach out into area of a local church such a community outreach by having free meals to community, an outside pantry for the hungry, and craft shows. Liz will set up a table with outreach handouts. Congregations should consider doing a needs assessment in community of church focusing on a discernment process of what the church is good at and has a passion to do. Social media is a growing idea for many churches and should be explored.

New Business:

Communications:

- A financial report was received from the Crossroads CP Church. The church continues to be active, however, there was a \$6,000 deficit for the last year. An oral report shared that Rev. Jack Ryan is retiring from VA in May and will be able to spend more time working with the church. Arkansas Presbytery should continue to pray for the growth of this church.
- A communication was received from Rev. Toby Davis stating he was resigning from the BOM as he is now living in Texas.
- A communication was received from Walnut Grove CP Church reported that Bro. Don Kennedy had resigned as pulpit supply due to family health concerns. The session is beginning a pastor search immediately and is asking Arkansas Presbytery to pray for the search process.
- A communication was received from the Pineville CP Church session calling Rev. Chris Anderson to be their pastor with the writing of the contract is still in process. Pending the receipt of this contract, a recommendation will be submitted to Arkansas Presbytery in the Board of Missions Report #2.

Moderators' Reports:

Rev. Mike Suttle: A report was sent on the Pine Bluff 1st CP Church indicating Communion is served quarterly, there continues to be Sunday School and Worship services each Sunday, monthly session meetings, three new members have joined the church, and there have been several improvements made to the physical plant of the church including the remodeling of the restrooms.

He also sent a report on the Bethesda CP Church indicating Communion is served quarterly, there continues to be Sunday School and Worship services each Sunday, and quarterly session meetings. Rev. Ron Fells is serving as supply pastor while the session is in search of a full time pastor.

A report was submitted on the Pine Ridge CP Church indicating Communion is served quarterly, there continues to be Sunday School and Worship services each Sunday, quarterly session meetings, with lay minister Lance Walker preaching each Sunday, and there continues to be regular community singing hosted by the church.

Rev. Ann Holley: The report on the Falls Chapel CP Church indicated Communion is served quarterly, there continues to be Sunday School and Worship services each Sunday, regular session meetings, there has been one new member join the church and one Baptism. Finances are reported to be good. The church conducts regular visitation and once a month the church helps provide a meal to the Lockesburg Senior Citizens Center. She was pleased to report that the church won first place in the city of Lockesburg Christmas Parade, hosted a hay ride to sing Christmas carols around the neighborhood, culminating with a hot dog supper. There have been shared worship services with the New Beginnings Fellowship on 5th Sundays as there are former members now attending this fellowship.

A report was given on the Fomby CP Church indicating Communion is served quarterly, there continues to be Sunday Worship services lead by the Rev. Ann Holley, there are quarterly session meetings, received one new member to the church but lost a member by death. Attendance continues to be around 12 each Sunday.

A report was submitted on the Dillworth CP Church indicating Communion is served quarterly, there continues to be Sunday Worship services lead by a Southern Baptist minister each Sunday, quarterly session meetings, and has an average of 12 in attendance for worship. The finances remain good to support the local congregation and the church gives donations to the CP Children's Home, local charities, to the Hopson CP missionaries in Africa, and to a program assisting military personnel who are in transition to civilian life that is lead by the son of Rev. Jim Fisk.

Rev. Nick Chambers: An oral report was given on the Walkerville CP Church with regular Sunday Services, quarterly Communion, and session meetings.

An oral report was given on the Camp Ground CP Church with regular session meetings.

Nick reported he had not been able to go to the Ben Lomond CP Church for session meetings. This lead to a discussion of the problem of moderators having difficulty driving long distances for session meetings. If there is a problem with Wi-fi in small churches, a mobile hotspot from a cell phone would allow for a video link such as Facebook Video Messenger or Skype. The board will get additional information on equipment needed to have such electronic meetings.

Rev. Jo Warren: A report was given on the Mt. Carmel CP Church indicated Communion is served quarterly, there continues to be Sunday worship services each Sunday, regular session meetings. Candidate Logan Dixon resigned as pulpit supply.

Rev. Bill Van Meter: A report was sent on the Marietta CP Church with regular services and singing. The church as sent in 5% of its OUO and a delegate to Presbytery.

A report was given on the Ft. Smith CP Church with Rev. Vondal Davenport providing regular worship services, Sunday School, the session is paying all dues and sends a delegate to Presbytery.

Rev. Victor Jones: A report was sent on the Bryon CP Church. Rev. Jones is preaching every Sunday, and there are Sunday School, 3rd Sunday potluck meal, regular session meetings, an active Women's ministry, and a nursing home service.

Rev. Dwight Skip Shanley: A written report was submitted to the board on the Rose Hill CP Church indicating Communion is served quarterly, there continues to be Sunday School and Worship services each Sunday, monthly session meetings. The church continues the pastor search process and has made some repairs to the manse.

On motion, the board approved the moderator's reports. As some of the Presbyterial appointed moderators do not use the Presbyterial recommended form, the Moderator's Report Form will be given out at Presbytery, and put it on website for ease of use.

Chris Anderson gave an oral report on the Mt. Olive CP Church support of two of their church members, Jake and Annie Osborne with their child born two weeks ago, are working with Beautiful Feet Ministry out of Oklahoma. The Osborne's will be missionaries to Asia and have sold their home and possessions to begin their work. Anne is Rev. Charles Faith's granddaughter.

Sherwood CP Church

As there was no financial report on the Sherwood CP Church, Rev. Buster Guthrie was asked to speak to the BOM. Rev. Buster Guthrie gave an oral report stating finances improving but problematic. Offerings increasing slowly, the church is making some monthly payments on their mortgage. There is Live Facebook Message broadcast of the sermons, and services are 10:30 Sunday morning and 6:30 Sunday evening services. There are women's singing group Tuesday night, and a men's singing group Monday nights, both give love offerings to the church.

BOM members were reminded to have unreimbursed milage expense for board business and for Presbyterial appointed session moderators be turned in for reimbursement.

Billy Clinton offered his resignation as he is a member of the Crossroads CP Church that is receiving financial assistance from Arkansas Presbytery.

Rev. Nick Chambers lead the closing prayer and the board adjourned at 12:08 p.m.

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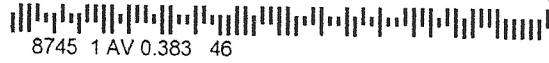

Arkansas Presbytery BOM Report
August 4, 2020
7:00 p.m. Zoom Meeting

(Mr. Dustin Taylor from the Camp Board arranged, set up, and provided the technical assistance for this Zoom meeting for the Board of Missions with Mickey hosting and sharing documents on the Zoom screen during this meeting.)

At 7:00 p.m. a quorum was declared by the chair with Ms. Melinda Reams, Rev. Chris Anderson, Mr. Bill Clinton, Mr. Mike Van Meter, Rev. Nicholas Chamber, Ms. Susan Suttle, Ms. Rocky Pederson, and Mr. Mickey Shell present. Ms. Liz Skidmore made numerous failed attempts to connect to this Zoom meeting that resulted in her not being able to attend. Mickey led the opening prayer. Melinda gave an update on the executive committee meeting that was held July 25 at the Sherwood CP Church. The committee decided that Arkansas Presbytery would meet October 10, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. at the Sherwood CP Church for both an in-person and virtual meeting.

The treasurer's report from Joyce Shell was reviewed and approved.

Old business:

Mr. Bill Clinton gave an update on the Crossroads CP Church reporting that services are now being held in-person, the offerings are continuing to be good, and that he was elected to the session. On motion the BOM voted to continue to support the Crossroads CP Church with financial assistance of \$16K for 2021.

The next item of business discussed was the Sherwood CP Church. Chris reported there was no information to report as he had been unable to meet due to the pandemic. After a lengthy discussion, the board voted that financial support will end December 31, 2020. However, if the board receives a Development/Vision Plan with objectives, goals, and a budget plan, additional support will be considered.

On motion, the board requested that Arkansas Presbytery continue to provide the same budget request from 2020 for the next year.

New Business:

Melinda brought up the idea of a Presbyterian Minister and it was discussed. Chris discussed a parish ministry as a way for Arkansas Presbytery to address the needs for small congregations to have pastoral leadership. There was much discussion about forming a subcommittee to consider on a parish ministry, virtual meetings for sessions and moderators, a presbyterial minister, and new ways for ministry. Melinda appointed herself, Chris, and Mickey to this subcommittee. On motion the board makes the following recommendation:

Recommendation #1: That Arkansas Presbytery approve a BOM Subcommittee comprising Ms. Melinda Reams, Rev. Chris Anderson, and Mr. Mickey Shell to be tasked with exploring new avenues of ministry for congregations in Arkansas Presbytery. Some examples to be considered are the use of lay speakers, parish ministry, virtual Session meetings, a presbyterial minister, circle of churches, and assistance in congregations finding a minister.

Communications:

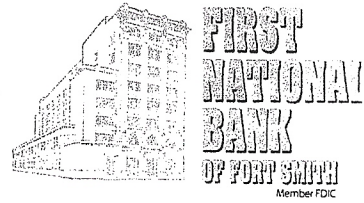

Committee on the Ministry Report

To the Presbytery of Arkansas Date: February 1, 2020

Presbyters:

The Committee on Ministry met September 13, 2019 at the Oxford Cumberland Presbyterian Church. Members present were: Rev Jo Warren, Rev Bill Van Meter, Rev Jason Chambers, Jerry Meinzer, Robert Clement, Helen McGowan, and Tom Johnson. The meeting opened with prayer.

The Committee received an oral report from Rev. SungtaeHong and the Elders of the Arkansas Loving Church. Rev. Hong is the new pastor of the Arkansas Loving Church. He was born in 1975 in Seoul, South Korea and has been in the US for 8 months. He is married and has 3 children. He spoke about his mother becoming a Christian when he was 5 years old and that was when he began going to church. Rev. Hong recounted an experience he had when he was 15 or 16 at a praise and worship service when the lyrics of a song touched his heart. He knew at that moment that God is alive. He shared a feeling he often had before his conversion that as the youngest child, he was a mistake. He wondered why his parents had not aborted him. He shared that in his country the way to escape extreme poverty was through suicide, and he had often dreamed about his death as a relief to poverty. The message he received from the praise song gave him affirmation that not only was God alive, but that he was not a mistake and God had a plan for him. Rev. Hong shared through study, God made him smarter and he felt better about himself. He had a very high SAT score that got him into the University in Seoul. After graduation he went on to Seminary. He has worked in Children's ministry, with Praise and Worship teams, and he led Bible studies in a Korean Church in China for 2 years. He feels that God gives the same authority to men and women. Due to prior engagements Rev. Hong was not able to stay overnight for questioning by the Presbytery on Saturday September 14, 2019.

The Committee went into Recess and closed in prayer until the Spring Board meeting February 1, 2020.

Recommendations#1: That Rev. Sungtae Hong be enrolled as a provisional minister in Arkansas Presbytery while completing the required Cumberland Presbyterian courses for recognition of his ordination.

The Committee on Ministry met February 1, 2020 at the Sherwood Cumberland Presbyterian Church for our regularly scheduled meeting. Members present were: Rev. Jo Warren, Rev Bill Van Meter, Rev Victor Jones, Rev Jason Chambers, Helen McGowan, Tom Johnson, Jerry Meinzer, and Robert Clement. The meeting was opened in prayer by Jerry Meinzer.

The first order of business was to elect new officers for 2020. Rev Jo Warren was elected to succeed herself as chair, Rev Victor Jones was elected to succeed himself as vice-chair, and Rev Jason Chambers was elected to succeed himself as secretary. Following the election of officers Robert Clement presented the financial report for the Spring meeting. After discussion of the financial report, the committee discussed the criteria to award the Rev Leo Smith Memorial Endowment. There were no current Candidates eligible to receive the endowment.

Appendix U of the standing rules of Arkansas Presbytery states, “A written report on activities such as education, church work, special projects, etc. is required BEFORE the committee meets the first Saturday in February and the first Saturday in August, and any other time the committee asks for it. Those attending Bethel College or Memphis Theological Seminary Must send a copy of grades for the previous semester and proof of enrollment for the next semester. All reports should be sent to the stated clerk at least ten days before committee meetings, so they can be duplicated and sent to committee members. Failure to properly report will result in the withholding of financial aid.

The committee received written progress reports from the following Probationers: Jimmy Vaughan, Elizabeth (Warren) Norris, Jana Cowgill, and Ethan Harbour.

Grade reports were submitted by Matt Fisk and Logan Dixon.

The committee met with the following candidates and received oral reports on their progress: Logan Dixon, Devin Walsh, Melissa Shatley.

The committee received written communication from Candidate Jana Cowgill who has completed her first class at Memphis Theological Seminary. Having already completed a Bachelor’s degree, the Constitutional requirement for licensure we discussed licensing her at the Spring meeting of Presbytery.

Recommendation #2: Having met the Constitutional requirement for licensure, that Candidate Jana Cowgill be licensed by Arkansas Presbytery.

The Committee received notification from the Session of the Pineville Cumberland Presbyterian Church recommending that Lila DeMoss be considered as a Candidate for the Ministry. Lila was introduced to the committee by her pastor, Rev Chris Anderson. Lila shared her background with the committee. She has completed Bachelor's degrees in both Psychology and Criminal Justice, and is already enrolled at Memphis Theological Seminary to begin her Master of Divinity degree. Lila shared that she was raised in the Roman Catholic church where there have always been limitations to women serving in ministry. This led her to the Presbyterian USA Church in Horseshoe Bend after retiring from the US Air Force. When she began discerning her calling her pastor mentioned to her that she would make a good Cumberland Presbyterian. She feels a calling to minister to the broken and lonely people who can't get to the church. People in Nursing Homes. She shared her feeling that this would be to serve as an Associate Pastor working with any other pastors who need assistance.

Recommendation #3: That Lila DeMoss be made a Candidate for the Ministry and enrolled in Memphis Theological Seminary to complete the Constitutional requirements for Ordination.

The Committee received a communication from the Mars Hill Cumberland Presbyterian Church requesting that Elder Linda Gibson be trained and certified as a Eucharistic Elder to serve Holy Communion in the absence of an Ordained Pastor.

Recommendation #4: That Arkansas Presbytery approve training and certification of Elder Linda Gibson to serve Holy Communion at the Mars Hill Cumberland Presbyterian Church.

The Committee on Ministry discussed the information on an Employee Assistance Program as presented by Rev Dr. Pam Phillips-Burke at the Fall meeting of Arkansas Presbytery.

Recommendation #5: That Arkansas Presbytery participate for a 1 year trial in the Employee Assistance Program.

ON NOVEMBER 28, 1955, JACK JOHNSON AND HIS WIFE OSA JOHNSON DEEDED LAND TO K.T. ALLEN (DEED READS K.T.) MEMORIAL CUMBERLAND PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH, FOR THE SUM OF \$1.00 AND OTHER GOOD AND VALUABLE CONSIDERATIONS. FOLLOWING THE LEGAL DESCRIPTION, THE FOLLOWING WAS PRINTED: "IF AT ANY TIME THIS PROPERTY IS NOT USED FOR CHURCH PURPOSES IT REVERTS BACK TO THE GRANTORS OR THEIR HEIRS". COURTS HAVE RULED THAT REVERSION CLAUSES OF THIS TYPE ARE ENFORCEABLE.

ON NOVEMBER 8, 2019, ALL MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION MET AT THE CAMDEN CP FELLOWSHIP CHURCH TO DISCUSS THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE E.T. ALLEN CP CHURCH. PRIOR COMMUNICATION HAD REVEALED THAT CHURCH WAS NOW CALLED "CHRISTION FELLOWSHIP – E.T. ALLEN MEMORIAL"

ON NOVEMBER 9, 2019, THE FOLLOWING COMMISSION MEMBERS MET WITH THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP CHURCH: ELDER TO: JERRY MEINZER, REV. ALAN MEINZER, REV. MIKE SUTTLE, AND ARKANSAS PRESBYTERY MODERATOR KEITH CLEMENT. THOSE REPRESENTING CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP WERE REV. RAY CROMER, CLERK GLEN BOWMAN, AND ATTORNEY ERIC T. BISHOP, ALONG WITH SEVERAL CHURCH MEMBERS.

MEETING WAS OPENED WITH PRAYER. REV. MEINZER EXPLAINED TO THEM THAT OUR MAIN PURPOSE WAS TO DETERMINE IF THERE WERE ANY CUMBERLAND PRESBYTERIANS STILL IN THE AREA THAT WISHED CHURCH TO REMAIN CUMBERLAND PRESBYTERIAN. (FUTURE NEWSPAPER ADS FAILED TO LOCATE ANYONE).

WHEN ASKED FOR THEIR THOUGHTS ON HOW TO HANDLE THE REVERSION CLAUSE ON THE DEED IF 15 OR MORE PEOPLE DID NOT RESPOND TO THE NEWSPAPER AD IN THE ASHDOWN LITTLE RIVER NEWS. THEIR ANSWER WAS THAT THEY WOULD LOCATE THE HEIRS AND HAVE ALL NECESSARY PAPER WORK COMPLETED BY DECEMBER 31, 2019. AT THIS POINT BOTH PARTIES WOULD AWAIT ARKANSAS PRESBYTERY VOTE ON RELINQUISHING ALL CLAIM TO SAID PROPERTY.

CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP ALSO AGREED TO TURN OVER ALL AVAILABLE CHURCH RECORDS, PROOF OF INSURANCE ON THE CHURCH, AND A COPY OF THEIR BANK STATEMENT FOR DECEMBER 2016. THIS HAS ALL BEEN HANDLED.

MEETING WAS CLOSED WITH PRAYER.

RECOMMENDATION #1: THAT ARKANSAS PRESBYTERY ADHERE TO THE FINDINGS OF THIS COMMISSION AND VOTE TO DISSOLVE THE CHURCH, AND RELINQUISH ALL CLAIM TO PROPERTY FORMALLY BELONGING TO E.T. ALLEN CP CHURCH.

WITH OUR WORK COMPLETED WE ASK THAT OUR COMMITTEE BE DISSOLVED.

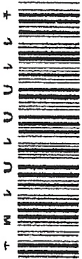

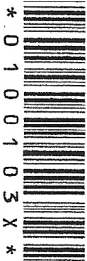
